# We all have **STRENGTH.**

God expects you to live in your STRENGTH.

## Opening

As a backdrop, we gather at this Rally in Washington, D.C. It is the seat of government for the people of the United States of America. Your nation, too, has a seat of government.

What is the name of your capitol?

Capitol cities are places of power. God gives our public servants power to exercise their function. That is why we are instructed to pray for them.

But power is not just for people in political positions. We all have strength. That is the definition of power. God expects you to live in your strength.

The Bible does not suggest power is bad, except when it is used improperly. In fact, Jesus commands His followers to seek the power of the baptism in the Holy Spirit. Power is good when we use it as an extension of, or as a steward of, God's power.

During this Rally, we will explore this question:

"How can a Royal Ranger wisely use their God-given strength to 'Serve all nations?"

### **Paul's Example**

1 Corinthians 10:31b-11:1 -

10:31b – Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

- 32 Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God,
- 33 just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.
- 11:1 Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ (English Standard Version).
- **1.** Paul used his God-given strength to follow Christ wholeheartedly, setting an example for others. Verse: 11:1, *"Imitate me."*
- 2. Paul used his God-given strength to clear obstacles that hinder people from following Christ. Verse 10:32, *"Give no offense."*
- **3.** Paul used his strength to creatively communicate the Gospel in a relevant manner. Verse 10:33, "Not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved."

Following Paul's example is a great model for Royal Rangers eager to use their strength to, *"Serve all nations!"*

**THIRD** — Underline one nation (anywhere in the world) that does not have Royal Rangers and begin to ask God to open the doors.


